## **Tech Guide: Coin Weight Settings**



Due to a number of reasons occasionally a CC804 coin counting scale new out of the box can have lost its coin weight PLU's and a calibration cannot resolve the issue, because of this the following guide has been created:

- With the scale switched on, long press TARE and ON/OFF/ZERO keys until SETUP is displayed.
- 2. Press the ADD/ENTER key, the display shows COIN.
- 3. Use  $\pm$  2/+200 ..... 1p/+1 keys to select which coin type you want to reset its piece weight. The arrow icon above the selected coin type will light to confirm the selection.
- 4. After the coin type is selected, firstly press the **ADD/ENTER** key, it displays the coin value (i.e. £1 should display 1.00, if it does not press the **ON/OFF/CLEAR** key and then press the £1/+100 key to correct the coin value displayed; for other coin values press the appropriate coin key e.g. 20p press the 20p/+20 key), then press the **ADD/ENTER** again, the display now shows the preset coin piece weight.
- 5. If the weight is wrong press the **ON/OFF/CLEAR** key to clear the preset coin piece weight to 0.000; Use £2/+200 .....1p/+1 keys to key in the coin weight you want to reset. (See table 2.3 below) The value that each key enters is shown as the +number below the coin value, e.g. 20p/+20 coin key enters, or adds, 20 to the displayed weight.

Displayed number position: - 0.ABC

The £2/+200 & £1/+100 keys enter or add a value in position A, i.e. hundreds 50p/+50, 20p/+20 & 10p/+10 keys enter or add a value in position B, i.e. tens 2p/+2 & 1p/+1 keys enter or add a value in position C, i.e. ones

Any roll over will increment upwards, e.g. position C will roll up to position B etc. if the 2p/+2 or 1p/+1 keys are repeatedly operated.

Pressing the **TARE** key toggles the MIX icon ON/OFF. In the ON position the numeric entry value of a coin key is multiplied by 10, e.g. **20p/+20** coin key enters, or adds, 200 instead of 20 and the **£2/+200** key will enter or add 2000 instead of 200.


## Tech Guide:

If the weight was correct simply press the **ADD/ENTER** key to return the display to COIN and select another coin value to set.

- After the coin weight is entered, press the ADD/ENTER key to confirm. The display will return to display COIN.
- 7. Use the same method to check / reset all of the £ 2/+200 .....1p/+1's coin piece weights.
- Pressing the MODE key when COIN is displayed returns the scale to the normal operating mode.
